The Book "Christian Heritage of Kosovo and Metohija" Gifted to the Hillman Library at the University of Pittsburgh

On January 4, 2016, on behalf of His Grace Bishop MAXIM of the Western American Diocese of the Serbian Orthodox Church in North and South America, Father Branislav Golic and I presented the book "Christian Heritage of Kosovo and Metohija" as a gift to the Hillman Library at the University of Pittsburgh. On behalf of the Hillman Library, the book was accepted by Ms. Fern Brody. Father Golic discussed with Ms. Brody various aspects of Serbian orthodox tradition and the importance of the availability of the book to the public. The book was accepted by the Hillman Library with gratitude.

The book was originally presented by His Grace Bishop MAXIM at a lecture "Christian Heritage of Kosovo and Metohija" in the Cathedral of Learning at the University of Pittsburgh on June 11, 2015. The lecture was sponsored by the Serb National Federation in cooperation with the Yugoslav Room Committee. The book was published by the Sebastian Press—The Episcopal Council of the Serbian Orthodox Church in North and South

America with co-publishers: Institute for Balkan Studies, Serbian Academy of Sciences and Arts, Belgrade; Faculty of Orthodox Theology – University of Belgrade; BLAGO Fund; Serbica Americicana; and Interklima-grafika, Vrnjci. The book includes over 750 vivid photographs and other depictions of Serbian monasteries, churches,

frescoes, icons, and historical figures of Kosovo and Metohija. In addition to the brilliant photographs and other artwork, the book includes 1,000 pages of history detailing the deep Christian heritage in this small region. This book gives us a number of historical facts about historical and Christian identity of the Serbian people in Kosovo and Metohija. His Grace pointed out that the original texts that accompany the photos "demonstrate that Serbia's architectural and art monuments in Kosovo rank among the finest achievements of medieval Europe."

The book is single-most important compendium of research and photographs of Serbian Christian heritage of Kosovo and Metohija and it is vitally important that it remains available to the largest section of the public as a learning tool. His Grace Bishop MAXIM hopes that the book will further encourage the public of the importance of preservation of these treasures of Serbian Christian heritage not just for Christians in Kosovo and Metohija, but for the world culture.
